Machinery & Equipment

In 1899 when the factory had been operating for more than a year the Company invested in:

- Sagar & Co Saw bench and Planing machine £130
- Brush Electrical Co 2 x 6hp motors and cables £217
- Sagar guards for saw and plane £6

In 1900/01 a Sagar Fuel sawing machine, powered by a Sunderland 1hp motor for £16 and £43 respectively, was added.

In 1924 Tenoning and mortising machines were acquired for £139 with two Maudsley motors for £68.

A handwritten document which appears to be the result of a complete stock take carried out upon Mr Adams retirement in 1926 suggests that at that point these were still the only machines in the factory, apart from a fret sawing machine. Some clue as to the size of the operation may be gathered from the fact that there were 21 benches, 4 Channon glue pots, 2 drawing boards and 1 tea urn.
